

SVG Centre Risk Assessment

All instructors and coaches will perform a daily risk assessment before any training is run. The following is a basic list, each sailing venue must review their own specific hazards.

Static Risks

- Any permanent rocks on the beach in the launching and landing area.
- Reefs downwind and upwind of the launching and landing area, and in the sailing area.
- Piers and floating docks downwind and upwind of launching and sailing area.
- Mooring ropes and buoys in the sailing area.
- Channel markers and other poles in the sailing area.

Dynamic Risks

- Other water users
- Boats on moorings in the sailing area
- Ferries and commercial traffic
- Wind strength and direction
- Temperature and Sun
- Approaching weather
- Availability of safety boats
- Sea creatures (sea urchins etc.)
